LIBERTY UTILITIES ANNOUNCES UPDATED MISSOURI ELECTRIC RATES

JOPLIN, MO – September 11, 2020 – The Missouri Public Service Commission (MPSC) approved updated electric rates for The Empire District Electric Company (Liberty-Empire). Residential customers with an average monthly usage of 1,000 kWh will see an approximate increase of 48 cents per month, a change of 0.37% percent. Liberty-Empire's last Missouri electric base rate update was effective September 14, 2016. Updated rates will go into effect beginning September 16, 2020.

Investments in Infrastructure and Reliability

Liberty-Empire has made significant investments to its system to decrease the number of customers affected by outages, including replacing over 6,400 poles and installing over 11,000 devices to improve reliability.

Other Bill Changes

The "Tax Cut and Jobs Act" itemized credit will no longer appear on bills for customers in Missouri because the lower federal tax rate of 21% is reflected in the new base rates.

Update on Credit Card Fees

The MPSC approved Liberty-Empire's request to stop the direct charge of the convenience fee that is currently applied when Missouri electric customers pay their bill using a debit or credit card online or by phone. Beginning September 16, Missouri electric customers who pay their bill with a debit or credit card online or by phone will receive a credit on their bill to reimburse them for the convenience fee. Once payment system upgrades are completed, expected later this year, the direct charge will be waived automatically at the time of payment.

Customer Assistance is Available

We would like our customers to know that we have various options available if they are struggling to pay an electric bill. We are currently offering Special Payment Arrangements to customers who qualify. In addition, we have programs in place, such as Project Help, the Low Income Pilot Program, and Action to Support the Elderly.
