The availability of this rider shall be limited to industrial and commercial facilities not involved in selling or providing goods and services directly to the general public.						
Applicability: The rider is applicable to new facilities or the additional separately metered facilities (when separate metering is unduly limiting, the Company may use a 2 year average to determine baseline usage for purposes of this tariffy meeting the above availability criteria and the following two applicability criteria:						
1. The annual load factor of the new Customer or additional facility is reasonably projected to equal or exceed ar annual load factor of fifty (50) percent within two (2) years of the date the Customer first receives service under this Rider.
