

Vegetation Management Notification

Liberty is committed to delivering safe, reliable electricity to our customers. As part of this commitment, we prevent future power outages by trimming and removing trees that may interfere with power lines.

A Right-Of-Way Inspector has identified right-of-way work described below. This work will be performed, at no expense to the property owner, when Liberty line clearance professionals are performing scheduled work in your area.

It is our desire at Liberty to inform and discuss our vegetation management practices with property owners. **Please call us as soon as possible if you have concerns or questions regarding the planned work described below.**

Width of prescribed work area: .

- □ Tree trimming work required.
- Tree removal required. Trees located in the right-of-way are unmanageable. Therefore, removal is necessary.
- Herbicide work required.
- Mechanical clearing required.
- □ Tree Growth Regulators required.

Crews will chip small limbs and branches. Larger wood is generally cut into pieces 18 to 24 inches long and stacked by the tree for the property owner's use.

A tree growth regulator (TGR) may be applied to your trees. TGR promotes healthy trees while slowing the vegetative growth and reducing the need for more frequent pruning.

Tree Care Maintenance


Liberty follows the best management practices for pruning trees as established by the International Society of Arboriculture, The Arbor Day Foundation, and the American National Standards Institute.
