APPLICATION:

Residential customers and certain commercial customers may elect to be billed and pay for electric service under the Budget Billing Plan (BBP) if the customer has satisfied the Company's credit requirements.

PLAN:

1. The monthly BBP contract billing amount shall be based on the Customer's previous twelve months of bills divided by the number of days in the billing cycles for that time period, and then multiplied by 30 to determine the monthly bill amount.. Where the Customer has less than twelve months billing history at his present location or the billing history is not representative, the monthly BBP contract amount may be based on estimates of monthly bills.
2. Differences between Customer's applicable rate schedule billing and BBP contract billings will be accumulated for 12 months and the outstanding balance due or owed will be applied to the next year's BBP.
3. The Company may adjust the amount of billing during the Budget Billing Plan Months whenever usage varies significantly from the plan estimate, or when a revision in the Company's rates have been approved.

TERMINATION OF PLAN PARTICIPATION:

1. The Company may terminate a customer's participation in this plan if the customer has failed to make payment when due. Billing adjustments required to balance the account will be included in the next regular bill.
2. The customer may terminate participation in the plan by requesting the termination in writing. The customer must pay any amounts due on the account, including billing adjustments.
3. Final bills, when issued on an Budget BillingPlan account, shall include any billing adjustments necessary to balance the account.

CONDITIONS OF AVAILABILITY:

1. This plan will be available only after the computer system to accomplish implementation has been completed.
