



June 16, 2026: Attention water customers in Rockaway Beach, Mo.

Due to damage to a main, Rockaway Beach water customers may see disruptions to their service as repairs are made. A map of the affected area can be found below. Once repairs are complete, customers will be under a precautionary voluntary boil advisory. The advisory will allow for a required bacterial test to ensure the system is safe. Customers are encouraged to follow the safety guidelines below.

During a boil advisory, it is recommended that customers:

- Boil water vigorously for three minutes prior to use for cooking or drinking.
- Let water cool sufficiently before drinking.
- Disinfect food contact surfaces (dishes) by immersing them for at least one minute in clean tap water that contains one teaspoon of unscented household bleach per gallon of water.
- Dispose of ice cubes and remake with water that has been boiled.
- Water used for bathing does not need to be boiled.
