



**Feb. 9, 2026: Attention Oakbrier Estates customers in Poplar Bluff, Mo.**

Due to necessary repairs, water service will be shut down at around 8 a.m. Wednesday, Feb. 11, for Oakbrier Estates customers in Poplar Bluff, Missouri.

When water service is restored, customers will be under a precautionary voluntary boil advisory. This will allow for a required bacterial test to ensure the system is safe.

Customers are encouraged to follow the safety guidelines below.

During a boil advisory, it is recommended that customers:

- Boil water vigorously for three minutes prior to use for cooking or drinking.
- Let water cool sufficiently before drinking.
- Disinfect food contact surfaces (dishes) by immersing them for at least one minute in clean tap water that contains one teaspoon of unscented household bleach per gallon of water.
- Dispose of ice cubes and remake with water that has been boiled.
- Water used for bathing does not need to be boiled.
